In accordance with the UGB notice no- CoE-341/UGB/CE – 2020, dated-14/09/2020 P.G. Examination Cell of Balurghat is notifying for all concerned as follows:

1. P.G. 4th Semester Examinations will be conducted in Online Open Book Examination (OBE) mode.
2. On the date of the scheduled examination, concerned HoDs / Coordinators of the Departments will circulate paper wise soft copy of the question set among all the examinees via WhatsApp groups 30 minutes before to the commencement of the examination.

3. Write the answers in clean and blank foolscap / A4 papers preferably with black ballpoint pen.
• The students have to write- (i) Page number, (ii) name of College, (iii) the name of Examination, (iv) name of the student, (v) Roll & No (according to Admit card), (vi) Registration no & session (vii) name of Department, (viii) Paper Code and (ix) Paper name on the front page of answer scripts. On the other pages write only (i) page number, (ii) Roll & No (according to Admit card), (iii) Paper Code and (iv) paper name.
• The students have to draw narrow margin around each pages of the answer scripts.
• Only the handwritten answer scripts will be accepted. Computer typed or generated answer scripts will not be accepted.

4. After completing their examinations the students have to send the scanned hand written answer scripts, preferably in jpeg format in the order of page numbers to the mail ID, which will be mentioned on the bellow of each question paper. The scanned answer scripts of different papers have to send to different mail IDs. The students have to send their answer scripts within 30 minutes of the end of examination.
• However, in worst situation, if a student still remains unsuccessful to submit his/her answer scripts to specific mail ID; then student will be allowed to submit his/her answer scripts to the 'collection center' at Balurghat College. The student will have to submit the answer script within 30 minutes of the end of examination following all the recommended guidelines of COVID-19.

5. A downloadable 'admit card' will be provided to the examinee through the College website / WhatsApp groups.
